


About Us



DCR Park Interpretive Programs & Calendars


- Free and open to the public. An adult must accompany children.
- Reasonable accommodations available upon request.
- In case of inclement weather, confirm by calling the park.
- Parking fees may apply.
- Please follow all current COVID guidelines. Visit <u>mass.gov/COVID</u>.

Accessible Parks

- mass.gov/dcr →
 "Find a park"
- Type in address and select from list
- Scroll through, click on "Get directions and more information"
- Look for ACCESSIBLE icon and Accessibility link in menu
- If you can't use the park finder, <u>contact</u> <u>UAP</u>

DCR Accessible Camping

- Find a campsite: <u>Reserve a</u> <u>campsite | Mass.gov</u>
- You can reserve a site any time between one day and 4 months before your arrival date.
- There is a 2-day minimum stay at most campsites.
- You can stay for a total of 14 days at each campground between Memorial Day and Labor Day.
- Accessible camping is offered at <u>selected campgrounds</u>.
